International Youth Exchange Programme 2011-12

Invitation for Joining IYEP 2011

The Commission on Youth and the Home Affairs Bureau are going to invite cadets / officer trainees from the Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps to apply for the above programme, which aims to provide opportunities for youths to broaden their horizon and international perspective, and to exchange ideas and experiences with their counterparts in other countries. The selection criteria are:

- a. be aged between **18 and 24 as at 1st April 2011**;
(i.e. born between 1987-03-31 and 1993-04-01)
 - b. be proficient in English;
 - c. be knowledgeable about Hong Kong;
 - d. have good knowledge on China;
 - e. have good common sense and good academic background;
 - f. have record of volunteer/community service in the past three years; and
 - g. have a valid travel document.
2. Successful candidates would be arranged to visit UK, Japan, Ireland, Singapore or other countries and the place to be visited by each successful candidate is subject to the recommendations of the selection board. The length of stay is usually from 7 days to 2 weeks and tentatively will be sometime between July 2011 and March 2012.
3. **All expenses including air tickets, board and lodging are provided by the HAB with personal travel insurance excluded.**
4. Candidates selected will be required to :
- a. attend all pre-tour briefing sessions, meetings, rehearsals, etc
 - b. prepare presentation of HK to other countries;
 - c. take part in the report-back meetings;
 - d. compile a report on the visit within one month after the trip;
 - e. organize a group presentation on the exchange programme at a selected school within two months after the visit;
 - f. receive the overseas delegates when they visit Hong Kong; and
 - g. attend the functions organized by the HAB or the Commissioner on Youth as and when invited or requested.

5. Nominees selected for interview should be prepared to attend a group interview in April 2011, and be prepared to have a very busy schedule before and after their visit.

7. Forms to be submitted :
- a) Duly-completed nomination form
 - b) Copies of Certificate of Public Examinations
 - c) Academic transcripts; and
 - d) A detailed account of community involvement including voluntary and social services (specify the position held and duration of service and attached documentary proof signed by OIC of the Program).
