## Government Flying Service Aviation Inspiration Programme (GAINS) Module 1 - Call for Applications

The 7<sup>th</sup> cohort of "Government Flying Service Aviation Inspiration Programme" (GAINS), a programme in collaboration with the Government Flying Service ("GFS") is now open for application with details as follows. Under the "Youth Engagement Work of Disciplined and Auxiliary Services Departments" of the HKSAR Government, the establishment of a formal strategic collaboration between the GFS and the Corps has led to an enrichment of the GAINS programme structure.

Eligible Members	Members of all ranks aged below 25 (as at 23 July 2022);  Demonstrate excellent command of English and Cantonese, both
	oral and written;  Possess intense interest in pursuing a career in the aviation industry; and
	Be able to attend events with full attendance.
Mode	Participants will undergo intensive classroom lectures and practical training on various knowledge and skills relevant to different positions in the GFS including:
	Pilot: Helicopter Principles of Flight and Aircraft Systems;
	Air Crewman Officer: Search and Rescue and Winching Operation;
	Engineer: Introduction to Airworthiness and Workshop Detachment;
	Operations Officer: Air Command and Control Centre operation including Basic ATC Procedures, Meteorology and Aircraft Loading Fundamentals; and
	Air Medical Officer/Air Medical Nursing Officer: Basic Aviation Medicine and skill training.
	Familiarisation Flight

Language	English, supplemented by Cantonese.
Commitment	Participants will be constantly assessed and could be disqualified from the programme if performance is unsatisfactory.
Vaccine Pass and Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) Requirements	All participants are required to strictly adhere to the latest "Vaccine Pass" government issued directions. Participants will be required to present their vaccine pass record and utilise the "LeaveHomeSafe" App when entering training premises.

	On the day of the event, all participants are required to perform RAT before attending the event and take a photographic record of their test kit results with their names and the respective date marked on the kit clearly and submit it to the OIC for record.
Recognition	A maximum of 24 participants who have completed the Module 1 programme will be presented with a <i>Certificate of Completion</i> .
	Cadets who have full attendance and pass the assessment will be endorsed as completing the subject "Government Flying Service", "Aircraft Recognition", "Principle of Flight" and "Civil Aviation in HK" for respective Cadet Classification in Leading Cadet Levels.
Development	12 graduates will be selected from Module 1 for an internship programme (Module 2), a 2-day GFS attachment in Sep 2022 including intermediate training and operational exposure/opportunities.
	Successful completion of Module 2 will lead to recognition of 4 Aviation Education (AE) subjects at Senior Cadet or Staff Cadet level and the award of a <i>GFS Internship</i> reference letter.
	A 3-month mentorship programme (Module 3) will be tailored-made for 4 outstanding Module 2 graduates from Oct to Dec 2022. Each candidate will be paired up with either a pilot, aircrewman officer or aircraft engineer, for in-depth training, career planning and development in the aviation industry.
	Successful completion of Module 3 will lead to recognition of 4 Aviation Education (AE) subjects at Senior Cadet or Staff Cadet level and the award of a <i>GFS Mentorship</i> reference letter.

All applicants  $\it MUST$  also attend a briefing session prior to the programme. The details are as follows.

The organising committee will also contact the unit commanders concerned for endorsement.
