Aerodrome Control Trainees

The Aerodrome Control Trainees will be seconded to the CAD to receive professional air traffic control training leading to the issue of air traffic control licence and perform air traffic control related duties in the Aerodrome Control Tower at HKIA. They will be required to work irregular hours under the direct supervision/deployment of the CAD on a day-to-day basis.

Requirements

Applicants should be able to communicate effectively in English and also satisfy the following mandatory requirements:

- to have Level 3 or equivalent^{Note 1} or above in five subjects, with at least one of them being Mathematics, Geography, Physics, Information and Communication Technology or Aviation Studies, in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSEE)^{Note 2} or equivalent; or
- to have a pass in two subjects at Advanced Level in the Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (HKALE) and Grade C /Level 3^{Note 3} or above in three other subjects in the Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE)^{Note 2}, at least one of the other three subjects being Mathematics, Geography, Physics or Computer Studies, or equivalent
- to have met the language proficiency requirements of Level 3^{Note 3} or above in English Language and Level 2^{Note 3} or above in Chinese Language in HKDSEE or HKCEE, or equivalent
- to undertake designated medical check-ups and be certified as meeting the International Civil Aviation Organization's standards (including visual and other requirements) for Air Traffic Control Officers; and
- being a permanent resident of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

^{Note 1} "Attained with Distinction" in Applied Learning subjects (subject to a maximum of two Applied Learning Subjects), and Grade C in Other Language subjects in the HKDSEE are accepted as equivalent to Level 3 in the New Senior Secondary subjects in the HKDSEE. "Attained" in Applied Learning subjects (subject to a maximum of two Applied Learning subjects), and Grade E in Other language subjects in the HKDSEE are accepted as equivalent to Level 2 in the New Senior Secondary subjects in the HKDSEE

^{Note 2} The subjects may include Chinese Language and English Language.

^{Note 3} "Grade C" and "Grade E" in Chinese Language and English Language (Syllabus B) in the HKCEE before 2007 are accepted as comparable to "Level 3" and "Level 2" respectively in Chinese Language and English Language in the 2007 HKCEE and henceforth.
