Remarks:

- (i) Full-size medals and lanyards are to be worn.
- (ii) Escorting Officers, Parade Commander, Parade Adjutant, Squadron Commanders, Squadron Warrant Officers, Guard Commander, Guard Junior Officer, Parade Warrant Officer, members of the Standards Parties & Guards of Honour, Stick Orderlies and Orderlies shall wear white gloves.
- (iii) Female members on parade with swords or rifles shall wear slacks.
- (iv) Blue-Grey sashes are to be worn by Parade Warrant Officer, Squadron Warrant Officers, Stick Orderlies, Markers of the Guards of Honour.
- (v) Name tags are not to be worn by members on parade.
- (vi) No optional items in particular stable/purse belts are to be worn.
- (vii) Female members are to keep their hair neat and tidy and above the collar of the shirt/tunic. No ponytails are allowed.
- (viii) Horseshoe heel tacks are not allowed.
- (ix) The remarks should be read in conjunction with Dress Regulations issued by HQ.

10. Transportation

Transportation will be arranged for all cadets on parade in the morning of 27 March 2011. Due to the limited car parking spaces, guests and Corps members are advised to use public transport or car parking facilities near to the parade venue.

11. Assembly and Reporting

All members are to muster at the main entrance, Police Tactical Unit, and report to the Parade Warrant Officer 15 min before 0830 hrs on 27 March 2011.

12. Catering Arrangements

Lunch will be at the JPO Canteen and Outdoor Canteen. Members are reminded to bring along water for personal consumption.

13. After Parade Refreshments

Refreshments will be arranged immediately after the Parade at the Officers' Mess and Outdoor Canteen for VIPs and guests respectively.

14. Bad Weather Arrangement

The arrangement for the Parade shall follow the regulations issued by HQ.

15. Security

In view of the operational requirement of the parade venue, all Corps members and their guests are to stringently comply with the security and safety procedures in force within the PTU premises. Trespassing or photo taking is prohibited in the restricted area as indicated by signage or as directed by working party.
