Dragonair Aviation Certificate Programme 2014

The Dragonair Aviation Certificate Programme 2014 (DACP) is now open for application with details as follows:

Eligible Members	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Senior and cadet members aged 18 to 25 (as of the application deadline);2. Have an excellent command of English, both oral and written;3. Possessing an intense interest in pursuing a career in the aviation industry; and4. Able to attend the Programme events with full attendance
Quota	12-18
Mode	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participants will be fed into the DACP mentorship scheme, under which each mentee is assigned a Dragonair pilot guiding and assisting them in pursuing a career in the aviation industry- The programme will also involve a number of industry visits for mentees' comprehensive exposure
Language	English
Commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Due to the extreme difficulties involved in the arrangement of scheduled events, mentees are required to attend all events even if an event takes place on a weekday.- Mentees who fail to attend any event will be discontinued from DACP and thus unable to participate further in the Programme.

Application Deadline	20 December 2013 (Friday)
Remarks	Applicants are required to dress in business attire or No 2A / 2B routine working dress uniform during the Programme events. Applicants should ascertain that they will be able to comply with the dress code as instructed.

2. The tentative schedule for the selection process and training prior to admission is ----- available in Appendix II. **Full participation** in the selection process and training is mandatory.

3. DACP is well-recognized among the local aviation entities. HKACC members successfully completed the Programme will stand a very good chance of entering the industry. Since the launch, 145 participants have graduated and approximately 40% of them have already embarked a career in the aviation industry, including working as air traffic controllers, aircraft engineers, flight attendants and pilots for local airlines.

2. Initial Screening

Initial screening of the applicants will be jointly conducted by Dragonair and HKACC on 8 / 9 / 11 / 12 January 2014.

It will be beneficial if the applicants have already passed some AAEP subjects and practiced general flying skills on *Microsoft Flight Simulator* (especially on the Airbus A320/A330). An intensive preparatory training course for the finalists will be organized as shown in the schedule above.

3. Final Screening

Finalists will be invited to report at the Cathay City on 22 / 23 February 2014 for final selection, from whom 12-18 mentees will be appointed.

Details of the Final Screening will be made available to shortlisted applicants when time approaches.
