Discipline in Flying Operations

The Local Flying Operations are precious resources which are donated by volunteer pilots of Flying Squadron, with aims to be a learning tool in airmanship for our members. Absent without prior notice is an unacceptable behavior, which wasted the valuable flying hours and also deprived the opportunity of other members, who has genuine interest, to participate in the flying operations.

2. To ensure all of the passengers attending flying operations on time, the following rules and regulations are enforced with immediate effect.

- a. Passenger who could not attend, or reporting late in the flying operations, must seek approval from his unit commander, and inform HQ and duty Flight Operation Officer (FOO), at least 48 hours before the reporting time.
- b. Passenger who is absent due to acute medical condition, the duty FOO must be informed prior to the reporting time. Medical Certificate must be submitted to HQ within 24 hours after the flight for record.
- c. Absentee who violated the regulations a.) or b)., would be **banned from ALL local flying operations for 3 years.**

3. The Headquarter and Flying Squadron would keep a central database on the attendance on each flying operation. Unit commanders are reminded that they have the responsibility to ensure the passenger(s) under their command to attend the flying operations according to the joining instructions.
