**Glider Scholarships 2014 – 2015 – Invitation for Application**

The United Kingdom Glider Aviator Scholarships 2014 and the Operation Swift Glider Aviator Scholarships 2014 - 2015 are now open for application.

**The United Kingdom Glider Aviator Scholarships 2014** consists of two scholarships for the selected cadet members of the Corps aged 18 to 21 to undergo a two weeks' glider aviator training at the Air Cadet Central Gliding School, United Kingdom Air Cadet Organization between Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June and Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2014. Awardees shall arrive in UK in the morning on 29<sup>th</sup> June and depart in the evening on 11<sup>th</sup> July. No alternative arrangement on departure and arrival is available. All expenses in association with training, food, accommodation and air tickets are inclusive in the scholarships.

**The Operation Swift Glider Aviator Scholarships 2014 – 2015** consists of a maximum of four scholarships for the selected uniformed members of the Corps aged 16 to 25, regardless of rank, to undergo a two to three weeks' glider aviator training in New Zealand between December 2014 and February 2015 (Exact training periods shall be compromised among the scholarship awardees). The amount of subsidy is subject to the decision of the Selection Panel.

All applicants shall comply with the Rules and Regulations for the application of the Glider Scholarships 2014 – 2015 in Appendix I.

Interested members please complete the enclosed form and applications should reach **hkacc.aewing@gmail.com by 1800hrs, 25 April 2014 (Friday)**. Applicants should also submit a recent passport photo with your unit, rank, name and serial number at the back **to HQ by 1800hrs, 25 April 2014 (Friday)**. **Applicants who failed to follow the above procedures will NOT be entertained.**

Selection interview will be held on 30 April 2014 from 1900hrs to 2200hrs in Hong Kong Aviation Club. Exact interview time for individual applicants will be announced by 28 April 2014.

**Rules and Regulations for the application of the Glider Scholarships 2014 – 2015**

1. All applicants shall complete the No.1 Glider Introductory Course with 90% of attendance or above and pass the written examination to be eligible for the captioned scholarships.
2. Applicants may apply for both scholarships if qualified.
3. Successful candidates shall be certified by a qualified medical practitioner as medically fit for glider training and solo glider flying.
4. Successful candidates of the Operation Swift Glider Aviator Scholarships 2014 – 2015 need to pay for the full cost of the training. The expenses can only be reimbursed in the form of scholarship if he/she has successfully achieved the Gliding New Zealand A Certificate.
5. Successful candidates shall submit a report to the Officer Commanding Glider Flight within 3 months after return.
6. Successful candidates shall take up the responsibility of assisting Officer Commanding Glider Flight in conducting any Glider Training Programme in the future.
7. All successful candidates shall not use his/her ratings for any promotion outside Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps without the approval from Officer Commanding Glider Flight in advance.
8. Successful candidates who failed to comply with the Rules and Regulations are subject to administrative and/or disciplinary actions as considered appropriate by Officer Commanding Glider Flight, including but not limited to the forfeiture of scholarship.
9. The rules and regulations are subject to changes without prior notice. In case of any dispute, the decision of Deputy Commanding Officer, Training shall be final.
