## **Appendix I: Rules and Regulations**

### **Part I – Race Overview**

1. Tasks are categorised into three difficulty levels, with point values of **5, 10, or 15** points respectively, including **photo tasks, counting tasks, and video tasks**

#### **2. Distance Bonus Points**

Additional points will be awarded based on the area in which each task is located:

- a. **Central: +3 points**
- b. **Admiralty / Causeway Bay: +2 points**
- c. **Wan Chai / Bowen Road: +1 point**

#### **3. Area Bonus Points**

Points will be awarded as follows for completing all tasks in each area and answering all questions correctly:

- a. **Central: +40 points**
- b. **Admiralty / Causeway Bay +30 points**
- c. **Wan Chai / Bowen Road: +20 points**
- d. **HKACC Headquarters and Training Centre: +10 points**

4. All answers must be submitted via the designated Google Forms with QR codes printed in the booklet for your convenience

5. All answers should be gathered before the forms are submitted, as each team is only permitted to submit once

## **Appendix I: Rules and Regulations (Cont'd)**

### **Part II – General**

1. Participation fees and funds raised are non-refundable once an application is accepted
2. The Organising Committee has the discretion to cancel the event due to inclement weather or unexpected circumstances
3. All participation fees and funds raised are non-refundable
4. Inclement Weather:  
The event will be cancelled if Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or above, or a Red or Black Rainstorm Signal is hoisted by the Hong Kong Observatory at 0900 hrs or thereafter on the event day (22 March 2026, Sunday)
5. Unexpected Circumstances:  
The event will be cancelled if any natural disaster or public safety incident occurs (e.g. flood, fire, landslide, tree collapse, earthquake, damage of road, fights, riot, occupation, commotion, mass gathering etc.)
6. Participants should have detailed planning before starting and avoid dangerous routes
7. Please stay tuned to the weather forecast in advance
8. The Organising Committee reserves the right to disqualify or exclude any participants from the event who provide false personal information
9. In all situations, participants are required to comply with the directives of the Organising Committee to ensure the smooth execution of the event
10. Participants should understand the potential risks involved in taking part in the event and acknowledge the level of fitness required
11. Participants are responsible for ensuring that they are physically fit to participate and finish the event
12. Participants are suggested to seek medical advice in advance if they have any doubts
13. Participants should pay attention to their health condition before starting the event
14. They should not continue the event if they feel unwell
15. The format of the event may be changed. The Organising Committee will share the latest updates through email, memo and social media platforms
16. The Organising Committee reserves the right to use portraits of the participants, video or any record of the event for future promotional purposes
17. Participation in the event is strictly voluntary in nature and at each participant's own risk
18. Each participant confirms and agrees to comply with all arrangements and decisions made by the Organising Committee, bears the responsibility for personal accidents, injuries, and property losses that occur during the event or for any other reasons, and absolve the Organising Committee from all claims and liabilities
19. All matters and disputes are subject to the final decision of the Organising Committee
