Period: January – June 2015

Eligible Members:

3. Possessing an interest in pursuing a career in the aviation industry; and
4. Able to attend the Programme events with full attendance

Quota: 8-16

Commitment: Actively participate in all activities and interaction with Mentors in the Programme. There will be around five to six functions throughout the programme period.


Language: Cantonese and English

Appendix I – Tentative Schedule of Mentorship in the Sky 2015

This schedule is tentative only and subject to change from time to time. Mentees will be notified as soon as any change is made.

1. Professional Tour (January 2015)
 - ▶ 1-day or 2 sessions of half-day tour to HK International Airport, CAD etc.
 - ▶ Providing overall understanding of key aviation facilities, scope of work in aviation, overall development in aviation
2. Aviation Training and flying experience (February to March 2015)
 - ▶ 1-2 intensive training sessions on flight operations, engineering, inflight services and airport services, plus flight experience with fixed-wing aircraft and helicopters
3. Community Service (April to May 2015)
 - ▶ 1-2 times of community service by organizing visits to such as elderly centre or special needs children centre
4. Practicum (June 2015)
 - ▶ 2-day practicum on aviation related workplace led by Mentor 1
 - ▶ 2-day practicum on commercial workplace led by Mentor 2
5. Overseas Missionary Tour (educational overseas experience)
 - ▶ An educational overseas experience by paying visits to such as world-class flight training centre and aircraft factory etc.
 - ▶ This will not be included in 2015' programme due to limited budget, but target to kick this off with sufficient sponsorship in the coming years.
