青年飛行夢實現計劃 – Visit to the Civil Aviation Flight University of China

Located in Sichuan Province, the [Civil Aviation Flight University of China](#) (CAFUC, 中國民用航空飛行學院) is the exclusive full-time regular institute of higher education for civil aviation pilots and other civil aviation professionals in the Mainland. CAFUC has state-of-the-art facilities and equipment for aviation training, including five well-equipped flight training airports, 383 flight training aircraft of 20 different types, as well as 40 flight simulators and exercise consoles. Besides flying training, CAFUC offers 42 undergraduate programmes and 20 master's degree programmes in various aviation expertise.

2. CAFUC and the Corps will jointly organize the captioned programme, with the support of the Government Flying Service. The details are as follows.
