REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD OF THE HONG KONG AIR CADET CORPS GOLDEN JUBILEE MEDAL

1. Eligibility

The Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps Golden Jubilee Medal shall be authorized for acquisition by

- (a) Corps Members whose service falls between 1 April 2021 and 31 March 2022; and
- (b) Members of the general public who actively supported the Corps, whose eligibility shall in each case be determined by the Executive Board upon recommendation by the Commanding Officer.

2. Description

The Medal shall be oval shape in sterling silver with gilt plating surmounted by an Air Force Eagle, and suspended from a ribbon thirty-two millimetres in width. Featured on the ribbon are the three facing colour of the Corps: Maroon, with Navy borders on both sides, and superimposed by twin Sky Blue stripes. Running down the length of the Sky Blue stripes are gold linings to underscore the 50th anniversary of the Corps' founding.

On the observe side of the Medal are (a) a three bladed propellor to symbolise the three key qualities of a leader - Honesty, Tolerance and Justice; (b) a pair of wings to represent Aviation Education; (c) the North Star to stand for Leadership Development; and (d) the Maltese cross to denote Community Service. The numeral "50" is intertwined with the above design features. Circumscribed on the upper edge are the Chinese titles "香港航空青年團", and on the lower edge, the English titles "Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps".

On the reverse side the HKACC official emblem is the central motif placed in between the figures "1971" and "2021", with the Chinese characters "金禧紀念" and "GOLDEN JUBILEE" being respectively the upper and lower legends on the edge.

3. *Order of Wear*

The Medal shall be worn above the left uniform pocket with precedence after the Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps 40th Anniversary Commemorative Medal, and before all Foreign Orders, Decorations and Medals.

4. Recommending Authority

Wearing of the Medal by eligible members shall be authorized by the Executive Board upon recommendation by the Commanding Officer, and a notification of such authorization shall be duly published.
