- Explain the Functional Approach to leadership as applied in the RAF.
- Plan, organise and execute, as a leader, accomplish tasks, safely and within given limitations, using the Functional Approach principles.
- Demonstrate the ability to control and motivate a team to achieve a given task.
- Identify with the role of subordinate and recognise the value of effective teamwork.

ACLC - ELIGIBILITY

- Excellent English Communication Skills
- Age 16-17 at the time of attending the course.
- >1 year service in HKACC
- Medically fit
- Not be above the rank of Sergeant on arrival on the course.
- Physically fit.
(run 1½ miles (approx 2.4km) in 12 minutes (male)
/ 13 ½ minutes (female))
