



## Guy Horridge BSc MSc MBA FCMI - Executive Director

Guy was born in 1957, to a service family. He was educated at Wellington College and Warwick University. He joined the Army in 1976 and served mainly with the Airborne Gunners in most parts of the world. In 1988 he received an MSc from Cranfield and then the following year an MBA in Defence Studies from Kings College, London.
